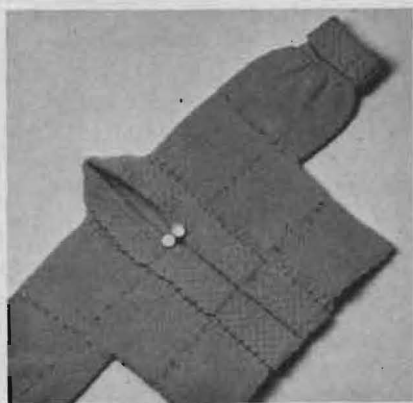


Sleeves: Ch 36 (38-40-42-42), turn. Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each ch across, work pat to last st. Attach a separate strand of MC in base of last st, ch 34 (36-38-40-40). Fasten off chain. Pick up working strand, dc in each ch across. Continue in pat, inc 1 st each side every 3rd row twice. Work even until sleeve edge measures 4½ (4½-5-5-5¼)".

Shoulders — Row 1: Sl st across first 4 sts, sc in next 4 dc, work pat to last 8 sts, sc in 4 sts, turn. **Row 2:** Sl st in first 8 sts, sc in next 4 sts, work pat to last 8 sts, sc in next 4 sts, turn. Repeat last row 6 times more, working all sts in CC when MC sts have been worked off. Fasten off.

Front: Work same as back.

Finishing: Steam-press lightly. Sew shoulder, underarm and sleeve seams. With right side to you using CC, work 1 row sc around neck edge. Work 1 row sc around each sleeve edge with MC.



"Weave-it" Infant Sacque

Materials: 1 HERO 4" Weave-It and 1 HERO Jr. Weave-It. 3 ozs. Baby Yarn; 3 small buttons. HERO Steel crochet hook Size 0.

Basket-Weave Pattern — First and Last Rows: Weave plain. **All Other Rows:** * U1, O3; repeat from * across, ending U1, O2. Pattern is same for 4" and Jr. Weave-It.

Weave 21 large squares in Basket-Weave pat. Weave 23 Jr. squares in same manner. Jacket can be made in plain squares if desired. Assemble as shown. Fold on dotted lines and bring X's tog on wrong side. Sew the edges

in place. Matching A and B markings, sew on collar. Fold at shoulder line and sew sides tog from G to H. Sew sleeves tog from C to D. Sew cuffs tog from E to F. Gather bottom of sleeves to fit cuffs and sew on cuffs. Set sleeves into armholes between H markings and sew. Work 1 row sc around entire jacket, working three ch-3 loops for buttonholes as indicated on right front. Work 1 row sc at bottom of cuffs. Sew on buttons. Steam-press lightly.



"Weave-it" Infant Jacket

Materials: HERO 4" Weave-It; 3 ozs. of Baby Yarn; 2 small buttons. HERO Steel crochet hook Size 0.

Basket-Weave Pattern — First and Last Rows: Weave plain. **All Other Rows:** * U1, O3; repeat from * across, ending U1, O2.

See chart on page 94 for assembling.

Weave 21 plain squares and 11 Basket-Weave squares. Assemble as shown. Sew on lapel collar matching A and B markings. Fold to outside on dotted line to form lapels and collar. Fold at shoulder line and sew sides together from G to H. Sew sleeves tog from C to D. Sew cuffs tog from E to F. Gather bottom of sleeves to fit cuffs and sew on cuffs. Fold back half of each cuff to outside on fold lines. Set sleeves into armholes between H markings and sew. Sew buttons in place as indicated. With crochet hook form buttonhole-loop fastening by making a chain 2" long. Join with sl st to form ring. With a wool needle make a few tight stitches around middle of chain, thus forming 2 loops. Slip loops over buttons. Steam-press lightly.
