

MAN'S RAGLAN SHIRT

derarm — 79 (85-91) rows above hem. **Raglan Shaping:** Bind off 5 sts for underarm, work pat to border; k 4, bind off 4 sts for buttonhole, k until 4 sts from bind-off, slip 1, k 4, bind off 4 sts; finish row. **Row 2:** Work front band and pat, casting on 4 sts over each buttonhole.

Keeping front edge even, shape raglan as for right side of back, repeating buttonholes every 15th and 16th row twice more. Finish to correspond to right half.

Sleeves: With size 4 needles, cast on 38 (40-44) sts for facing and cuffs. P 1 row, k 1 row for 14 rows. K 1 row inserting needle in back loop of sts for turning ridge. K 1 row, p 1 row for 14 rows. **Inc row:** K 2 (7-8) sts, inc 1 st in each of next 33 (26-27) sts, k 3 (7-9) sts; 71 (66-71) sts. With size 7 needles, work pat as for back for 11 (7-5) rows. Inc 1 st each side of next row; repeat inc every 16th (8th-10th) row 4 (9-9) times, with care to keep pat — 81 (86-91) sts. Work even until 14 (15-16)" above inc row, end on wrong side. Bind off 5 sts at beg of each of next 2 rows. Shape raglan as for back until 13 (12-11) sts on needle, end on right side. P 1 row, decreasing 6 (5-4) sts evenly spaced across row. Bind off 7 sts. Sew raglan seams.

Collar: From right side, with size 4 needle, leaving first 12 sts of right front facing on holder, beg with turning st, slip the next 15 (17-19) sts to size 4 needle; join yarn, pick up and k 10 sts on shaped neck edge, 6 (6-7) sts across sleeve, 21 (23-25) sts across back, 6 (6-7) sts across other sleeve; 10 sts on shaped neck edge, from wrong side, slip next 15 (17-19) sts of left front band to free size 4 needle, leaving 12 sts of facing on holder, k these sts — 83 (89-97) sts. P 1 row, k 1 row for 34 rows for facing. K 1 row from wrong side for turning ridge. K 1 row, p 1 row for 36 rows for top of collar, end on wrong side.

Next row: K 12, keep these 12 sts on back of needle, bind off 59 (65-73), k to end. Break yarn, leaving an end for weaving. Weave 12 sts at each end of collar to 12 sts at top of each front facing. Sew ends of facing tog.

Finishing: Sew seams. Turn facings to wrong side and sew. Sew bound-off edge of collar to neck edge. Finish buttonholes in blanket st. Steam lightly.



Shell Stitch Striped Pullover

Directions are for size 10-12. Changes for sizes 14-16 and 18-20 are in parentheses.

Materials: COLUMBIA-MINERVA Alpaca and Nylon (1 oz. ball): 6 (6-7) balls each of Colors MC and CC.

Boye Plastic crochet hook Size H OR SIZE REQUIRED TO WORK TO GAUGE.

Gauge: 1 shell and 1 sc = 2"; 4 rows = 2½".

Blocking Measurements: At bustline — 35 (38½-42)".

Back: With MC, ch 62 (68-74) to measure about 19 (21-23)". **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, * skip 2 ch, 5 dc (shell) in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across — 10 (11-12) shells. Ch 3, turn. **Row 2:** 2 dc in first sc (½ shell), * sc in center of next shell, 5-dc-shell in next sc; repeat from *, end 3 dc (½ shell) in last sc. Drop MC. With CC, ch 1, turn. **Row 3:** Sc in first dc, * shell in next sc, sc in center of next shell; repeat from *, end sc in turning ch. Ch 3, turn. **Row 4:** Repeat row 2. Drop CC. **Rows 5 and 6:** With MC, repeat rows 3 and 4. Drop MC. Repeat rows 3 through 6 for shell pat and colors. Work even until 12 (12-13) stripes have been completed. End with 2 rows of CC (CC-MC). Change to next color, sl st in last dc made, ch 43 (43-49), turn.

Sleeves — Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, * skip 2 ch, shell in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * until 7 (7-8) shells have been made, skip last 2 ch, sc in first dc, work pat across row, end with sc in turning ch. Drop yarn. Attach a separate strand of same color in base of last sc made, ch 42 (42-48) for other sleeve, fasten off. Pick up working strand, * skip 2 ch, shell in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across — 24 (25-28) shells across row. Ch 3, turn. Continue in pat until there are 5 complete stripes on sleeves. **Size 18-20 only:** Work 1 more row. Ch 1, turn. **Shoulders — Row 1:** Sl st to center of next 5-dc shell, sc in shell, work pat to center of last 5-dc shell. Ch 1, turn — 2 (2-1) shells dec. **Row 2:** Sl st to center of next shell, sc in shell, work pat to center of last shell. Ch 1, turn (1 shell dec). **Row 3:** Repeat row 2. **Row 4:** Sl st to center of 2nd shell, sc in shell, work pat to center of 2nd shell from end of row. Ch 1, turn (3 shells dec). **Rows 5-8:** Repeat rows 2 and 4 twice — 9 (10-14) shells remain. **Size 18-20 only:** Repeat row 4 — 11 shells. Fasten off.

Front: Work same as back.

Finishing: Steam-press pieces lightly. Leaving 5 (6-7) shells free at center for neck, sew shoulder seams. Sew side and sleeve seams. Turn under ½" hems on sleeves and sew. Press seams lightly.



Diamond Pattern Stole

Materials: 1 HERO 4" Weave-It. 10 ozs. of Baby Pompadour Yarn. HERO Steel crochet hook Size 0.

Diamond Pat — Row 1: Weave plain. **Row 2:** * U3, O1; repeat from * across ending U3. **Row 3:** W2, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W5, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W2. **Row 4:**

U3, O1, U3, O1, U3, W9, U3, O1, U3, O1, U3. **Row 5:** W2, U3, O1, U3, W13, U3, O1, W2. **Row 6:** U3, O1, U3, W17, U3, O1, U3. **Row 7:** W2, U3, W21, U3, W2. **Rows 8 and 9:** Repeat row 1 for both rows. **Row 10:** As row 7. **Row 11:** As row 6. **Row 12:** As row 5. **Row 13:** As row 4. **Row 14:** As row 3. **Row 15:** As row 2. **Row 16:** As row 1.

Weave 60 Diamond squares and 40 plain squares.

Diamond Strips — Make 3: Sew 20 diamond squares tog forming strips.

Plain Strips — Make 2: Sew 20 plain squares tog forming strips.

Sew a plain strip to each side of one diamond strip, then sew a diamond strip to each plain strip.

Crocheted Edge: Attach yarn at a corner, and working into center of each group of scallop-loops on long edges of stole, * sc in first group, 3 sc in next group; repeat from *, ending with sc in last group. Fasten off. Work other long edge the same.

Fringe: Cut 3 strands of yarn 10" long. Fold the 3 strands in half to form loop, with crochet hook pull loop through scallop-loop on narrow edge of stole, draw ends through loop, pull up tight. Make a fringe in every other scallop-loop across. Work other edge the same. Trim fringe evenly.



Man's V Neck Cardigan

Directions are for size 36-38. Changes for sizes 40-42 and 44-46 are in parentheses.

Materials: BUCILLA Alpaca-Mist (1 oz. ball): 10 (11-13) balls. 5 buttons.

Knitting Needles: 1 pr. each of BOYE needles No. 4 and No. 8 OR SIZE REQUIRED TO KNIT TO GAUGE.

Gauge: 5 sts = 1"; 7 rows = 1".

Blocking Measurements: At chest, buttoned — 40 (44-47½)"; across back at underarms — 20 (22-23)"; sleeve width at upperarm — 15½ (17-18½)".

Back: With size 4 needles, cast on 101 (111-115) sts. **Row 1 — wrong side:** P 1, * k 1, p 1; repeat from * to end. **Row 2:** K 1, * p 1, k 1; repeat from * to end. Repeat these 2 rows for 2", end with row 2. With size 7 needles, k 1 row, p 1 row — **purled side of knitting is right side of cardigan.** Work even until 12" above ribbing.

Armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of each of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each side every 2nd row 11 times — 73 (83-87) sts. Work even until armholes measure 9¼ (9½-9¾)".

Shoulders: Bind off 4 sts at beg of each of next 6 (14-10) rows: **for size 36-38,** bind off 3 sts at beg of each of next 8 rows (**for size 44-46,** bind off 5 sts at beg of each of next 4 rows). Bind off 25 (27-27) sts for neck.

Right Front: With size 4 needles, cast on 61 (67-71) sts. **Row 1 — wrong side:** * P 1, k 1; repeat from * to within 9 sts of end, p 9 for front hem. **Row 2:** K 9, * p 1, k 1; repeat from * to end. Repeat these 2 rows until same number of rows as on back ribbing, end with row 2. With size 7 needles, k to within 9 sts of end, place last 9 sts on holder. P 1 row, k 1 row until 11¾" above ribbing, end with p row.

Neck Shaping — Dec Row — wrong side: K to within 8 sts of end, k 2 tog, k 6. Repeat dec at neck edge every 4th row 13 (15-17) times, shaping armhole as on back when same length as back to armhole and shaping shoulder as on back when same length to shoulder.

Right Front Facing: With size 4 needles, starting at front edge, take up 9 sts of facing. Join yarn; inc 1 st in first st, p to end; 10 sts. K 1 row, p 1 row until 26 ins. above ribbing, end with p row. Place sts on holder. Sew facing to front edge of cardigan up to first dec at neck edge, leaving remainder of band free.

Mark position of 5 buttons on right front, having lower button 4 rows above lower edge, next button 1 row above top of ribbing, top button 3 rows below first neck dec row and remaining 2 buttons evenly spaced between. Mark

position of 5 buttons on front facing opposite markers on right front.

Left Front: With size 4 needles, cast on 61 (67-71) sts. **Row 1 — wrong side:** P 9 for front hem facing, * k 1, p 1; repeat from * to end. **Row 2:** * K 1, p 1; repeat from * to within 9 sts of end, k 9. Repeat these 2 rows once. **Buttonhole rows:** P 2, bind off 3 sts for buttonhole, * work until 7 sts from bind off, bind off 3 sts for 2nd buttonhole, work to end. Cast on 3 sts over each buttonhole on next row. Continue ribbing until same length as right front, end at underarm edge. With size 7 needles, p to within 9 sts of front edge. place last 9 sts on holder. **Next row:** K 3, bind off 2 sts for buttonhole, k to end. Cast on 2 sts over buttonhole in next row. Repeating buttonhole opposite markers on right front, work to correspond to right front until same length to neck shaping, end with p row. **Neck Shaping — dec row:** K 6, slip, k and pass, k to end. Complete to correspond to right front.

Left Front Facing: With size 4 needles, starting at front edge, take up 9 sts of facing. Join yarn at inner edge, inc 1 st in first st k 3, bind off 3 sts, k to end. Cast on 3 sts over buttonhole in next row; 10 sts. Repeating buttonhole opposite markers on facing, complete to correspond to right front facing. Place sts on holder, sew facing to front edge of cardigan up to first neck dec, leaving remainder of band free, matching buttonholes.

Sleeves: With size 4 needles, cast on 46 (48-52) sts. Work k 1, p 1 ribbing for 4". Work 1 more row of ribbing, increasing 17 (23-27) sts evenly spaced across row — 63 (71-79) sts. With size 7 needles, k 1 row, p 1 row for 2". Inc 1 st each side of next row; repeat incs every 1½" 6 times — 77 (85-93) sts. Work even until 15" above ribbing, end with p row. Bind off 3 sts at beg of each of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each side of next row and repeat decs every 2nd row 11 (10-9) times; every row 17 (22-26) times — 13 (13-15) sts. Bind off.

Finishing: Sew seams. Weave ends of facings tog and sew to shaped neck edges and back of neck. Turn back facing, folding 2 sts from seam so that 2 sts of facing form a binding on right side, hem to wrong side. Sew in sleeves with sleeve seam at center underarm. Finish buttonholes in blanket st, working through both thicknesses. Steam-press lightly.
